

Bennett Egg Drop

Where: Blacktop between main school building and multi-purpose room

What: Student-built egg “landers” will be launched from a 70-foot high ladder by Bellevue firefighters (pending no fires). Bring your unsealed, eggless device to school Wednesday morning, ready to load. Parent volunteers will visit classrooms, providing each entry with an egg which the student (or group of students) must seal into the container. Bring tape or other means of closing the “cradle” once the egg is in place.

Limitations on “landers”: The **entire** contraption must be small enough to fit through a basketball hoop – larger devices cannot be carried up the ladder. No helium balloons. The PTSA also reserves the right to refuse gratuitously messy, obvious splatters, or potentially dangerous entries. Please keep fruit and produce (or anything designed to splatter instead of protecting your egg) at home for the safety of others and in consideration of the janitorial staff.
