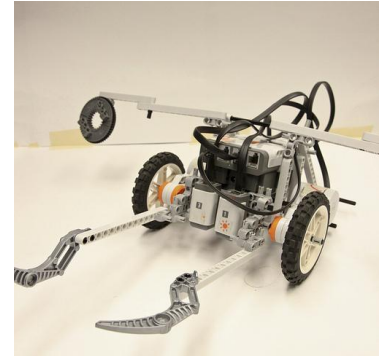




Join Bennett's next great club: BULLDOG ROBOTICS!

FIRST (For the Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) is a nationwide organization dedicated to helping inspire the next generation of America's leaders in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). To do this, FIRST organizes a series of robotics competitions across the nation for pre-college students, beginning in elementary school.



The FIRST Lego League (FLL) is an extension of FIRST exclusively for elementary and middle school students. Using specialized parts manufactured by Lego®, students construct robots that compete to perform "missions," with the objective being to rack up the highest score. The competition also includes a research project, based on the game's theme.



Interlake Saints Robotics and the Bennett PTSA have partnered to bring you the unique opportunity to join a new FLL team based out of Bennett that will teach young leaders to be more effective communicators, leaders, programmers, and builders, while introducing them to the design process- and it is always a LOT of fun!

Interlake High School Saints Robotics team members will mentor these students and help them come up with ideas to construct their robots, but will do little of the actual building or planning themselves- Bennett students will plan and construct the robot.

A portion of the funding for this novel project will be supplied by students on the team, as well as by the Bennett PTSA and the Interlake Saints Robotics team, and we anticipate the cost to each student to be approximately \$50 for two inspiring months with us.

The Bellevue Regional FLL Competition is scheduled for the first week of December, and registration for the Bellevue Regional FLL competition will close very soon.
